To our sponsors and partners, thank you for your contributions throughout the year. Without your support it would be impossible to get our teams on the field.

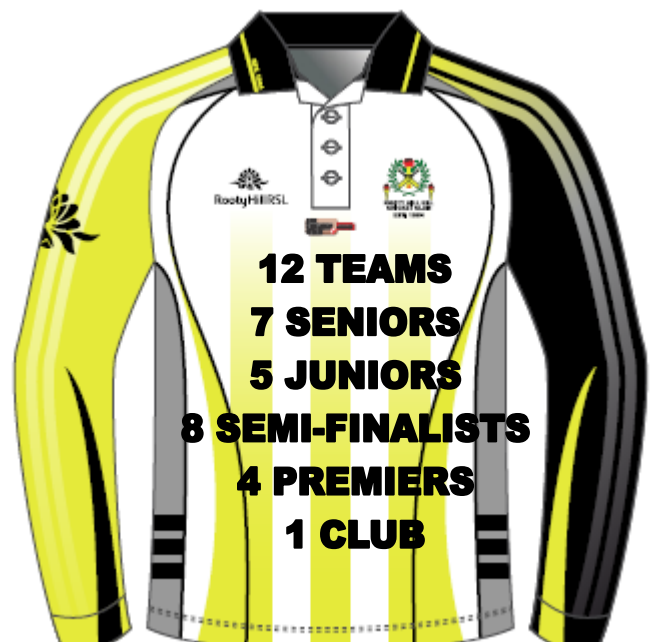

TREASURER'S REPORT

Congratulations to all players on another amazing year of cricket. As always, thank you to our Executive Committee Nick, Jarrod & Leanne, as well as our General Committee for your continued support this season. Without everyone, the club would not be able to run as smoothly and successfully as it does. As always, the club is looking for new committee members to join. Please come along to the AGM and nominate yourself for the general committee if you would like to be a part of the committee.

It is not a simple decision made, but each year, as a committee, we take into consideration our expenses and proposed income, and use these to work out the best way we can set our club registration fees and keep them to a minimum. By doing this, we survive with the support of our sponsors and the fundraisers that are run throughout the year. If we didn't have these in place, the club would not be able to maintain such low fees.

There have been several changes made over the last couple of years meaning some of your membership fees, with a fee structure in place requiring all clubs to now register through an online portal. From the fees paid to that portal, some are used to cover the charges for the portal itself, some go straight to BCDCA to cover the fees they normally charge the club. What is transferred to us goes to expenses such as playing equipment, player & social shirts (which can be purchased multiple times throughout the year depending on our requirements), first aid items and umpires' fees. These umpires' fees vary week to week and depending on how many teams in the semi-finals and finals, this can be thousands of dollars weekly.

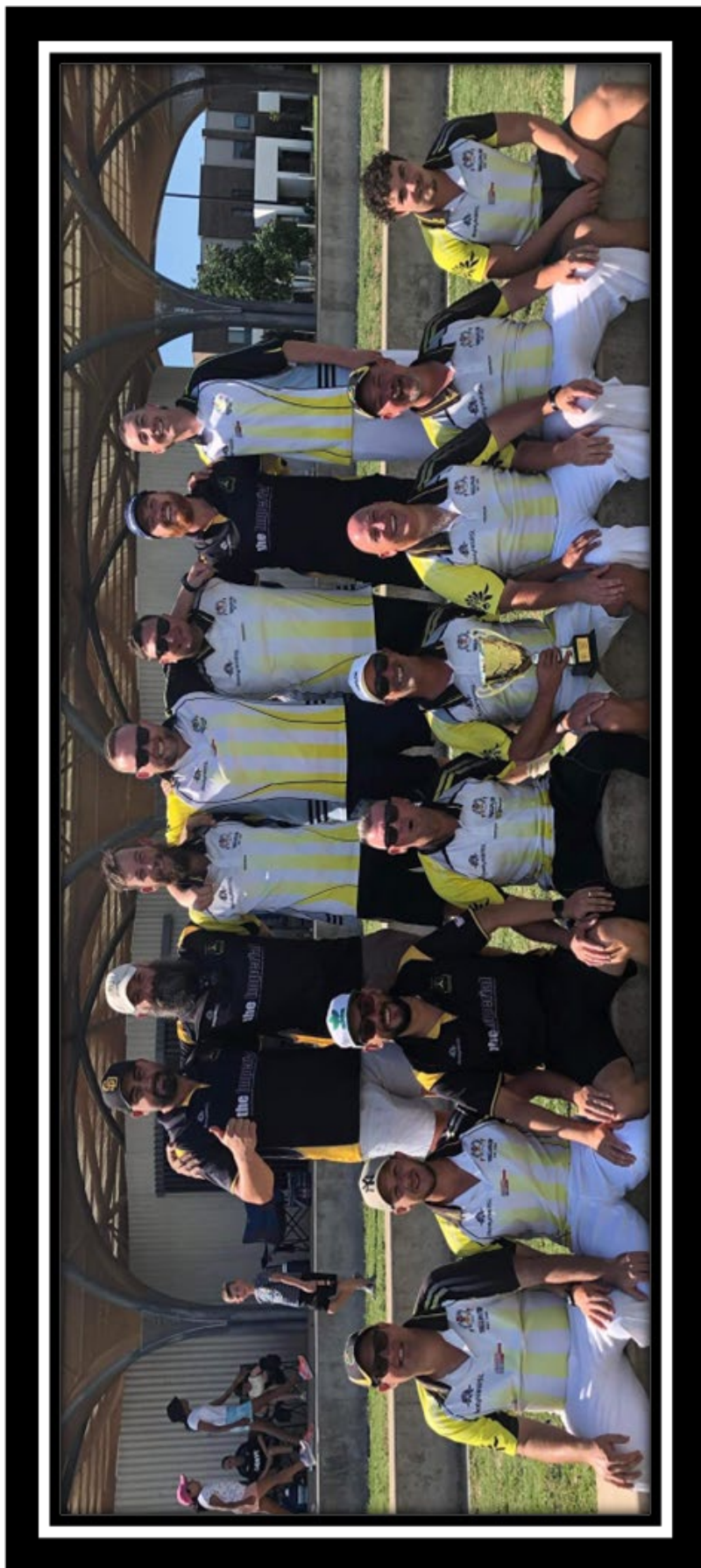
Blake Speed – it was great to have Blake come back to the club this year, he bowled well taking 14 wickets and always gave 100% in the field.
